Local Rules - Main Course

- OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)**
 - Beyond any fence or hedge bordering the course.
 - When playing the specified holes; beyond the white posts, to the right of the 1st fairway and to the left of the 3rd fairway, and beyond the white posts and conifer hedging to the left of the 10th fairway.
 - The rough slope marked by white posts in the 15th fairway, beyond the white posts to the left of 15th fairway.
- STONES AND BUNKERS (RULE 24-1)**
Stones in the bunkers are movable obstructions, and may be removed without penalty.
- STAKED TREES (Rule 24-2)**
If a staked tree interferes with a player's stance or his/hers intended swing, the ball must be lifted without penalty and dropped in accordance with Rule 24-2b (within one club length of the nearest point of relief).
- SPRINKLERS (Rule 24-2)**
All pop up sprinkler heads, travelling sprinklers and their hoses are immovable obstructions and relief may be obtained under Rule 24-2b.
- LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26-1)**
All lakes on the 4th, 17th and 18th (marked with red posts) to be played accordingly.
- WATER HAZARD (Rule 26-1)**
The ditch running across the 9th fairway (Marked with yellow posts).
- All visitors are advised to take extra care when going onto the golf courses in wet conditions as slopes & steps will be slippery.

INSURANCE & SAFETY

Everyone is advised to ensure they are adequately insured whilst playing golf. In the interests of safety, please ensure no one is in range, before playing a shot.

COURSE ETIQUETTE

To ensure everyone enjoys their game of golf to the full please observe the following: It is the duty of every golfer to keep pace with the game in front. Please give greenkeeping staff priority on the greens until waved through. Please replace divots, repair pitchmarks and rake bunkers. Please keep trolleys and bags off tees and green aprons. Playing without a shirt or wearing athletic style shorts is not permitted. Every player must have their own bag of clubs. Course wardens regularly patrol the course and have the power to eject anyone misusing the facilities. CCTV in operation for public safety and centre security.
